RE: Permanent Fund Trustee Opening

SK William D. Hartman, REPGC, has announced he will not be running for re-election as Trustee of the Grand Commandery Permanent Fund, and will be stepping down effective at the 167th Conclave in May. The Grand Commandery sincerely thanks SK Hartman for his service as Trustee, and for all he continues to do for Freemasonry in general and Templary in particular.

While any Sir Knight. in good standing as of the 167th Conclave is eligible to run for Trustee, and there are no established criteria, the preferred candidate will have a background in financial matters, money management, or institutional investing as well as a history of Masonic involvement in general, and Templar involvement specifically.

Sir Knights interested in running for the position of Permanent Fund Trustee should submit a brief resume listing both Masonic and financial experience, to the Grand Commander, Richard F. Muth, at the address shown above.

While any eligible SK may announce his intention to stand for election as late as the 167th Conclave, we strongly request resumes be submitted no later than May 1, 2020. (As of this writing, one candidate has announced his intention to run).

This announcement is to be read in its entirety during at least two Conclaves prior to the 167th Annual Conclave, assuming the Commandery meets twice in that time, and entered into the permanent records.
