You probably know that the image above is of the Friend to Friend Masonic Memorial, you may know the story, and may also be able to name the two Masons depicted, but did you know that it was not the only act of Masonic Charity that occurred during the Battle of Gettysburg? It is estimated that of the approximately 164,000 troops at Gettysburg at least 6,500 were Freemasons. Many of them performed great deeds on those fields. Come join with your fraters to hear some of their stories where they took place.

- Saturday, September 15, 2018, starting at 1pm
- 1.5 to 2 hours in length, returning by 3pm
- Lead by the Deputy Grand Commander, a Master Masonic Scholar and author of several articles on the Civil War in Knight Templar Magazine
- There is no charge for this tour
- Transportation will be provided
- Starting and finishing at the Gettysburg Museum and Visitor Center, 1195 Baltimore Pike. (If you are not already familiar with the Battle, you may want to tour that facility, and see the short film, prior to our trip. There is an entrance fee for the Museum as well as for the film and Cyclorama.)
