# **ORGANIZATION**

Sir Knights,

I want to express my humble appreciation to you for your trust in electing me to serve you as your Grand Commander for this Templar year. There is no greater honor nor responsibility than to serve God and mankind. In addition, I take this opportunity to express my sincere gratitude to all those who have and continue to support me throughout this journey, especially my loving wife Rebecca.

The theme for this Templar year is "By the Grace of God." Further, these occasions provide an opportunity for Sir Knights to meet and socialize with other Sir Knights and their families. These social events allow us the occasion to demonstrate positive knightly virtues via manners, protocol, and respect while sharing time and fellowship with those we care about. Whatever branch of service, including Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, or Coast Guard, past or present, you are and have helped keep our country and our families safe. Thank you for your service. As a token of honor and respect for those not able to be with us we will have a "Fallen Comrade or Missing Man Table" at all relevant occasions.
